Sara grew up in the US but has lived in the UK for the last 38 years, mostly in Scotland. She is a fine singer, storyteller and banjo player, with a particular strength in the art of ballad singing. Sara has a particular interest in the change and evolution of songs and ballads as they have migrated across the Atlantic. She has performed at hundreds of folk clubs and festivals, appeared on radio and TV, toured extensively in the US, Canada and Europe and has numerous solo and collaborative CD recordings.

This workshop will dramatically change the way you approach songs and ballads and help you to bring them to life through better interpretation of the story. Sara will explore natural dynamics, how to handle dialogue and narrative, making the most of vowels and consonants and ensuring the song makes sense to the listener.

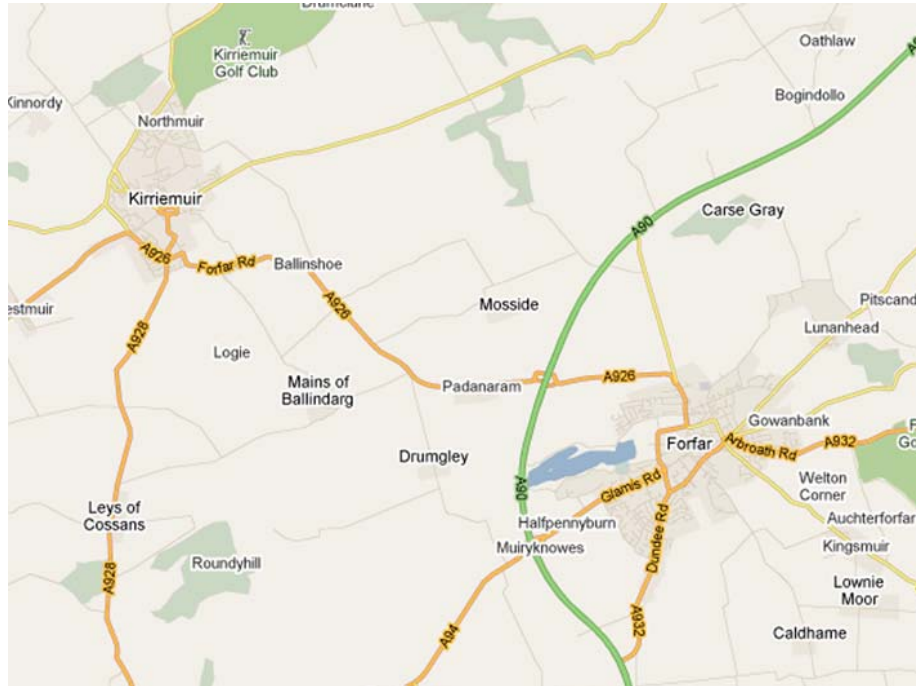
